

Customs declaration for international Flight from or to Lausanne airport

This registration for cross-border flights shall be established in accordance with General customs regulations, directives of the customs office or the provisions of the authorization. **The pilot must transmit this form electronically to the aerodrome operator**, who will forward it to the customs authorities. The form must be sent to the airport not later than 30 minutes before departure and 1 hour prior to arrival for intra-Schengen flight. As **extra-Schengen** flights have to be systematically controlled, the announcement has to be sent at least **1 hour prior to departure or arrival**.

Customs clearance

On arrival or departure, the crew and the passengers must present their luggage at the C office in order to make the customs formalities (possible customs control).
 Crew members and passengers **carrying goods purchased abroad** must complete customs declaration form 11.17 and place it in the customs declaration box on the second floor with receipts and any other appropriate documentation.
 The pilot **must volunteer information concerning any repairs or maintenance work carried out on the aircraft while abroad** (whether registered in Switzerland or abroad).

The information concerning the crew and the passengers will be passed to the competent body in charge of borders control. The data will be kept during five years. The electronic transmission of the data is not specifically secured.
